**RE: PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING PRCA MEMBERSHIP**

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Applicants desiring to obtain a Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Timer membership are required to complete the enclosed membership application which must be notarized and accompanied by the following:

- Intern at a minimum of two (2) PRCA rodeos
  - Must have a minimum of 5 performances combined between the two rodeos
  - Stand-alone events will not be accepted
  - Internship will be at Timer's expense
- At each intern rodeo, a New Timer Evaluation Form should be filled out.
  - Form will be provided by rodeo secretary
  - Form must be signed by rodeo secretary, one judge, and one timer from each rodeo.
- Upon completion of internship, timer should mail in a completed PRCA membership application and copies of timer evaluation forms.
- Prior to membership being issued, applicant will need to take the PRCA Timer Training program.

Upon completion of all requirements, evaluation forms will be reviewed, and a final membership determination made.

If all requirements are satisfied and the applicant is recommended for approval, the applicant will be approved for PRCA Timer status. The Timer card annual dues are \$205, which includes the mandatory PRCA Insurance.

Annual dues for renewal of membership for a Timer membership card must be submitted each year thereafter.
